Herbie has been saving \$4 each week for 11 weeks. How much money has he saved altogether?




ANSWER:



Penny has been saving \$2 each week and now has \$42 altogether. How long has she been saving for?


ANSWER:

Banjo is saving for a surfboard which costs \$56. He has already saved \$33, how much more does he need to save?


